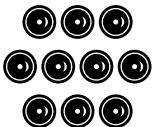
Authenticated bottles, optimized estimates, refined marketing tools, stylish communication, Baghera/wines' experts employ themselves to make your auction a most exceptional moment.

1 APPRAISALS & INVENTORIES



First of all, Baghera/wines graciously estimates your wines - whether a few bottles or an entire collection - according to the wine list and photographs you send in for appraisal.

Our appraisals are based on the observation of actual and concurrent transactions on the market and of recent auction records, revealing the value at which your bottles may find a buyer on the fine-wines' market.



Upon request, Baghera/wines' experts can carry out an inventory of your cellar; after which, a written document is addressed to you. Inventories are offered graciously to consignors who choose to put their wines up for auction with Baghera/wines.

2 VALUATIONS & EXPERT ADVICE

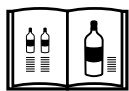
4 SHIPPING YOUR WINES TO OUR WAREHOUSE



Several weeks before the sale, wines selected for the sale will be delivered to our warehouse in Geneva, where the bottles will be photographed, catalogued and stored in optimum conditions.

Upon request, we may assist you in the handling of the wines and on all the logistics from your cellar until the delivery of the wines in our warehouses in Geneva.

5 PREPARING THE SALE & THE CATALOGUE

6 THE SALE

7 PAYMENT & STATEMENT



You receive payment for the lots sold at the auction 35 days from the day of the auction. The payment comes with a detailed statement listing all the consigned lots, the total amount of each sold lot's hammer price and the costs for each party. If a lot remains unsold, we examine its situation after the sale and propose a suitable solution.
