Under the banner of the now-famous “Kipling” formats, this ninth edition brings together iconic estates and rare vintages, perfect to elevate the winter months and enrich the cellars of the most discerning connoisseurs.

This sale continues Baghera/wines' tradition of excellence, a recognised expert in the art of evaluating and selling rare wines. "At home" will take place on February 21st, live streamed from the Club 1865 of Baghera/wines in Geneva. The auction offers a hand-picked selection of exceptional wines, taking collectors on a true journey through France's most prestigious wine regions, from Burgundy to Bordeaux, through the Rhône Valley and beyond. In total, 404 ultra-rare lots that showcase the expertise of Baghera/wines and its ability to unearth the most coveted treasures.

top lots: treasures for connoisseurs

Lots 1 to 31: Chablis Collection

This section reveals a masterful collection of Premier and Grand Crus from the benchmark estates of *Domaine Raveneau* and *Domaine Dauvissat*. With rare vintages, these wines combine the finesse and purity of the Chablis terroir, offering a true invitation to a sensory journey.

Lots 84 à 154 : Grands Crus de la Côte de Beaune

A tribute to the greatest white wines in the world, featuring prestigious Grand Crus such as *Corton-Charlemagne*, *Bienvenues-Bâtard-Montrachet*, *Bâtard-Montrachet*, *Chevalier-Montrachet*, and *Montrachet*. These exceptional cuvées, often regarded as the finest in Burgundy, have been carefully selected from rare vintages to offer an unforgettable sensory experience.

Lots 155 to 165: Domaine de la Romanée-Conti

One of the highlights of this auction is undoubtedly the section dedicated to *Domaine de la Romanée-Conti*, featuring rare and precious bottles, including a case of 6 bottles of *La Tâche* 2013, as well as 5 mixed cases from iconic vintages: 1985, 1999, 2016, 2017, and 2018. These lots are highly sought after for their impeccable provenance and the unmatched quality of the wines.

Lots 225 to 265: Domaine Georges Roumier

An exceptional vertical of wines from the prestigious *Domaine Georges Roumier*, featuring cuvées from the Premier Crus *Les Combottes*, *Les Cras*, and *Les Amoureuses*, as well as Grand Crus *Bonnes-Mares*, *Musigny* and *Echézeaux*. These wines, with their complex and elegant aromas, are a testament to the unparalleled craftsmanship of this legendary estate in the *Côte de Nuits*.

Lots 362 to 386: Château d'Yquem

The auction also highlights a vertical of *Château d'Yquem*, spanning a range of exceptional vintages from 1901 to 2007. This selection includes original bottles from the legendary estate, renowned for their longevity and refinement, offering collectors a unique opportunity to acquire some of the most sought-after cuvées in the world.

In 2018-19, the historic auction of Henri Mayer's personal cellar, to date the world's most important wine auction ever (CHF 34.5M), followed by an unprecedented auction exclusively dedicated to the wines of the Domaine de la Romanée-Conti and then by the final bottles from Domaine René Engel, propelled Baghera/wines to the position of European leader in wine auctions.

The experienced team working with Baghera/wines' experts offers excellent tailor-made professional advice to international collectors passionate about rare fine wines including the organization of masterclasses, as well as careful selection of wines for private tastings, dinners and events combining music and wine. In September 2020, Baghera/wines officially inaugurated its new Geneva establishment, incorporating a private club and boutique dedicated to fine wines, within the Beau-Rivage hotel, Geneva. In October 2022, the company further developed its activities in Asia, with the opening of Baghera/wines Singapore Ltd. The entity began holding physical and online auctions in Singapore from December 2022. In 2023, Baghera/wines France was set up to organize auctions in France, and a second club dedicated to collectors and events was inaugurated in Nuits-Saint-Georges.
