The star lot of "Kingdoms" by Baghera/wines and unique in the world, this part of Giorgio Pinchiorri's collection is made up solely of large formats - 6 and 3 litres - wines from the Domaine de la Romanée-Conti 1985 vintage, numbered labels n°1, n°2 and n°3. The lot consists of 24 large format bottles, including 12 jeroboams (3 litres) and 12 methuselahs (6 litres), for a high estimate of over 2 million Swiss francs.
