Geneva, the 29th of September 2025 — On Friday, September 26, 2025, Geneva-based Baghera/ Wines successfully concluded its 14th Kipling sale, entitled "À table", achieving a white-glove result: 397 lots offered, 397 lots sold, totaling CHF 1,378,665. Baghera/wines recorded record participation, including absentee bids orders, telephone and online bidders, which attests to the enthusiasm of amateurs for auctions.

Global passion for Burgundy's greatest wines

Dedicated to Burgundy's most prestigious crus, the sale showcased iconic estates such as Comte Liger-Belair, Armand Rousseau, Roumier and Mugnier, attracting an international audience of collectors and wine lovers. Highlights of the sale included:

- Lot 347 6 magnums of Chambertin 2009, Domaine Armand Rousseau, sold for CHF 36,600
- Lot 38 6 bottles of *La Romanée* 2019, Domaine du Comte Liger-Belair, sold for CHF 31,720
- Lot 37 6 bottles of *La Romanée* 2011, Domaine du Comte Liger-Belair, sold for CHF 23,180

The sale drew more than 120 registered clients and over 50 active buyers, including 10% new bidders. Strong absentee participation and highly competitive online bidding highlighted the global appeal of these rare bottles, with buyers spread across Europe, Asia and South America.

The experienced team, brought together by Baghera/wines experts, offers tailor-made, local, and excellent advice to international collectors passionate about fine and rare wines: organizing masterclasses, expertly selecting wines for private tastings, dinners, and events combining music and wine. In September 2020, Baghera/wines inaugurated its new Geneva location, a private club and boutique dedicated to fine wines within the Beau-Rivage Geneva. In October 2022, the company further expands its operations in Asia, with the opening of Baghera/wines Singapore Ltd, in Singapore. The entity began organizing physical and online auctions in December 2022. 2023 saw the creation of Baghera/wines France, an entity capable of organizing auctions in France, and a second club dedicated to collectors and event activities was inaugurated in Nuits-Saint-Georges.
